
The **Purpose** of the presentation is to:

National CDS Policy

- On **20 April 2017** the 'National Policy for an Integrated Career Development System for South Africa' was published in the Government Gazette (vol.622, no.40795)
- The Policy has a national footprint that spans national government departments and also directs implementation at provincial and local government levels
- Its purpose is to build an integrated CDS system for South Africa

CDS Vision



Strategic Policy Themes

- Career development services across the lifespan of an individual;
- Improved access to career development services;
- A single, coherent and coordinated Career Development System;
- An enabling environment for career development services to take place, including the development of a CDS Policy Implementation Framework that will inform the compilation of CDS Policy implementation plans by stakeholders; and
- Coordination and leadership in the Career Development System

POLICY DIRECTIVES



Policy and the Spheres of Government

Each department has the specific responsibility to provide and manage career development activities in the sector for which it is responsible through **specific legislative and policy mandates**

Provincial departments, local government, organisations and institutions are also responsible for career development activities in various forms.

The **DHET, in collaboration** with other government departments and different **spheres of government**, will develop adequate measures to guide the implementation of career development services in the country.

Purpose of the National Career Development Forum

The NCDF is an **advisory forum** established to **bring stakeholders together** and to promote **ongoing coordination**, development and **sustainability** of the national integrated Career Development System

The **Provincial and Local Career Development Forums** are sub-structures of the NCDF carrying the same purpose as the NCDF

CDS Sustainability

The DHET will establish a National Career Development Coordinating Structure to coordinate and manage operations of and provide shared services to the CDS system

It is envisaged that current CDS, which is functioning as a project within the DHET will be converted into the National Career Development Coordinating Structure

With support from the Governmental Technical Advisory Centre, a Government Component of the DHET is proposed as an institutional mechanism for CDS.

The Government Component is the most suitable for implementing the national coordination function



A free online self-help tool designed to facilitate and support informed career and study decisions

A one-stop platform for information on careers and related learning pathways, institutions of higher learning and courses and programmes they offer.

A comprehensive career resource for learners, students, unemployed youth, parents, career practitioners and workers looking to make career changes.

What Does NCAP Offer?

Information on over 1400 careers available in the labour market and information on learning pathways to these careers

Career videos for each occupation (status: over 700 video uploaded project to be completed in September 2018

Information on careers (occupations) in high demand and a focus green skills

Information on all public postschools education and training institutions and the courses they offer

Subject Choice & Questionnaires

A variety of non-standardised career questionnaires designed to facilitate self-exploration and a system generated report upon completion of each.

A subject chooser tool which helps the user to link subjects to careers and careers to subjects. A user could simply select subjects they are thinking of choosing to see which careers these subjects could lead them to and vice versa.

Careerhelp Website/Mobi-site

The Careerhelp website is a one stop shop for all career related matters. This site is an information resource designed to help all individuals make an informed career decision
